

WARRANTY STATEMENT

SAFEALL warrants that products will be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of Two (2) years from the date of shipment, subject to the conditions and restrictions contained herein.

SAFEALL further warrants all parts furnished with and installed on the new product covered by this warranty for the same time period. All parts furnished outside of this warranty are warranted for a period of thirty (30) days from date of shipment.

The above warranty is contingent upon the proper use of the products and does not apply to products on which the original identification marks have been removed or altered. In addition, this warranty shall not apply to defects or failure due to: (a) accident, neglect, abuse or misuse; (b) the use of items not provided by SAFEALL; (c) unusual stress; (d) any party other than SAFEALL or an authorized SAFEALL representative installing, modifying, adjusting, repairing or servicing the product; (e) storage, use or operation of products in an environment or application not intended or recommended by SAFEALL; (f) the failure to provide normal maintenance to the product; or (g) the use of products in combination with any equipment, parts, components or products not made, supplied or approved by SAFEALL.

This warranty covers only equipment and parts manufactured by SAFEALL. All other components and accessories furnished with any SAFEALL product are sold only with the express warranty, if any, of the manufacturers thereof.

SAFEALL ALSO DISCLAIMS ALL EXPRESS, STATUTORY, OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING THE WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, APPLICABLE TO USED PRODUCTS, ENGINES AND PARTS, V-BELTS, FILTERS, CABLES, LIGHT BULBS, FUSES, CARBON BRUSHES, ELECTRIC WIRES, AND HOSES. THE ONLY WARRANTY, IF ANY, APPLICABLE TO THE ATTACHMENTS DESCRIBED ABOVE SHALL BE THE WARRANTY OF THE MANUFACTURERS OF THE ATTACHMENTS.

In the event any product is found by SAFEALL to be defective during the warranty period, buyer expressly agrees that its exclusive remedy and SAFEALL sole responsibility shall be the return and replacement or repair of the product, at SAFEALL option, in accordance with SAFEALL then prevailing policy. SAFEALL does not pay for transportation charges, or any incidental or consequential damages connected with removal of a product deemed to be defective, or with installation or replacement of repaired product.

IN NO EVENT SHALL SAFEALL BE LIABLE FOR ANY REASON TO BUYER FOR, AND BUYER HEREBY WAIVES, SPECIAL, INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OR ANY DAMAGE RESULTING FROM

LOSS OF USE OR PROFITS, LOST OR DUPLICATED TIME OR EXPENSE WHETHER SUCH CLAIM IS MADE IN CONTRACT, TORT OR OTHERWISE.

SAFEALL reserves the right to make changes in its products without incurring any obligation to incorporate such improvements in any products previously sold or in service.

The terms and conditions of this warranty cannot be altered without the written consent of SAFEALL.

This warranty does not apply to any product that has not been paid for according to the terms under which the product has been invoiced. In addition, SAFEALL will not honor any warranty claim from a customer whose account at SAFEALL is not current according to SAFEALL payment terms.

The buyer may have seen advertisements or other distributor literature or heard statements made during a sales presentation that suggest that the product being sold has qualities or characteristics that make it attractive.

Even if a dealer or distributor made these statements deliberately, SAFEALL has no liability for them unless they are included in this warranty, and they are not part of this bargain in any way. Distributors and dealers have no authority to give warranties that exceed those listed herein and the buyer is warned therefore to check this warranty carefully to make sure it correctly reflects those terms that are important to the buyer.

EXCEPT FOR THE EXPRESS WARRANTY PROVIDED, SAFEALL DISCLAIMS ALL WARRANTIES, INCLUDING THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

WARRANTY CLAIM PROCEDURE

To make a claim under this warranty, contact SAFEALL and give a description of the product. Request a Return Goods Authorization (RGA) number.

After receipt of RGA number, please return the product–freight prepaid–to SAFEALL. If found to be defective, and if all return freight charges have been paid, or authorization to return "freight collect" is received, SAFEALL will repair or replace the product, at our option, and return it to the buyer.

In emergency cases where it becomes impractical to wait for warranty consideration by SAFEALL, parts will be shipped on account of the buyer pending warranty evaluation. Buyers without an established account with SAFEALL are shipped parts C.O.D. Upon completion of the warranty evaluation, the buyer will be reimbursed for the charges if the warranty covers such parts.
